Proposal (section 1)	Provides a clear, concise statement of proposed question and argument. Provides a clear description what resources will be consulted. Demonstrates clear engagement with psychological theories from the course and a question relevant to IR. The proposal does not exceed 1 page.	Provides a proposal, but some elements are missing or unclear. For example, the question or argument lack focus, or there is no indication of how the argument will be advanced.	The proposal paragraph is incomplete or demonstrates limited or no understanding of the topic.

Annotated Bibliography	Provides an annotated bibliography with at least 5 high quality references. The bibliography is formatted professionally, and full citation information is included for each entry. Each entry includes a paragraph that concisely summarizes the reference's question, main argument, methodology, and relevance.	Provides an annotated bibliography that is missing some information, such as incomplete citation information for some entries or annotations that do not include an indication of why the resource is relevant to the paper.	Provides a bibliography that is mostly incomplete or contains severe limitations. For example, many or most of the bibliographic entries lack citation information or annotations.
